### **How are implants fitted?**

A relatively simple minor sterile surgical procedure can be performed under local anaesthetic in our dental surgery. Intravenous sedation can be used for nervous patients. Implants are placed gently and precisely. Treatment is only carried out after detailed and careful assessment of each patient.

### **What is a dental implant?**

A dental implant is a small screw shaped attachment made from titanium. It is inserted into the jawbone to replace a missing tooth root. Once osseointegration (where the bone grows onto the implant to secure it) has occurred a replacement tooth can be fitted to the top of the implant.

### **Are implants for everyone?**

Most people can have implants. We will examine your mouth in detail and advise you if you are suitable for implant treatment.

### **Are there different types?**

There are several different implant systems available. The ones we use have been used successfully for many years and are backed by sound research. Implants can be used to replace a single missing tooth, a number of missing teeth or can be used to help hold a denture in place.
